## **Elimination of School Property Taxes**

This legislation will eliminate the existing School Property Taxes for homeowners. Revenue will be replaced by increasing the following existing taxes:

- State Personal Income Tax from 3.07 percent to 4 percent
- State Sales and Use Tax increases from 6 percent to 7 percent
- Close the Sales and Use Tax "special interest" loopholes
- Gambling revenues

It will also expand the list of existing items covered under the Sales and Use Tax to include some currently exempt products and services.

- Food (only items that are not on the Women, Infant and Children program food list)
- Clothing and footwear (only items that cost \$50 or more)
- Non-prescription drugs
- Professional services
